#### What is Olle?

## Easy-to-access, fun-packed walking trails.

Olle is the collective name for walking trails in Jeju, South Korea. They are now very popular with trekkers wishing to re-discover the beauty and wonder of nature through their own five senses, Modeled after the success of Jeiu. Kyushu Olle has established 17 courses throughout the island starting with the Okubungo Course. Ribbons and Kanse (horse-shaped guide posts) similar to those in Jeju serve as guides that you can follow at your own pace.








Blue and red ribbons tied on tree branches and elsewhere mark the correct route.

Place an advance order for a bento (box lunch) before you start and pick it up at Magaibutsu Chaya restaurant located at Fukoii Temple about 4 km away. \*Large groups should place their order well in advance. Individuals are also advised to ask if delivery is possible,
